What is this type of Insurance?

This cover can help to protect you against a financial shortfall between the claims settlement figure and the market value of your vehicle in the event of a total loss claim.



What is insured?

In months 0-36

- The difference between the settlement from your motor insurance and the purchase price of the vehicle; or
- If greater the early settlement figure of your finance agreement

In months 37-48

 The difference between the settlement from your motor insurance and the early settlement figure of your finance agreement



What is not insured?

- The excess shown on your schedule
- Vehicles not listed in the glass's guide
- Any claim arising from the driver being intoxicated by alcohol or under the influence of drugs
- Any claim arising from the vehicle being driven illegally
- Any claim where the driver is not insured on comprehensive motor insurance policy covering the vehicle
- Any amount in excess of the market value according to the Glass's guide



Are there any restrictions on cover?

- ! Your vehicle must have been purchased for less than £175,000, be less than 8 years old and have less than 80,000 miles on the odometer
- ! We will not pay more than the limit of indemnity shown in your schedule
- Your vehcile must be covered by a comprehensive motor insurance policy for the full duration of this policy
- ! You must ensure all security devices and immobilisers are activated and in full working order at all times
- ! This policy mut be purchased within 105 days of taking ownership of the vehicle



Where am I covered?

✓ England, Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales, Isle of Man and the Channel Islands. The Vehicle is also covered in the European Union, Croatia, Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, Liechtenstein and Andorra for a maximum of 90 days in any 12 months of cover, providing the cover provided by Your Motor Insurer is an equivalent level of cover as You would have enjoyed in the United Kingdom (UK).



What are my obligations?

- You must provide full and accurate information to all questions asked. Your answers must be true to the best of your knowledge and belief. Your answers will form part of the statement of facts on which your policy will be based. When and how do I pay?

You can pay your premium as a one-off payment, annually or in monthly instalments.



When does the cover start and end?

Your cover will start and end on the dates stated in your policy documents.



How do I cancel the contract?

By telephone, email or post. If you cancel your policy within 14 days from the date of purchase or the day on which you receive your policy documentation, whichever is the later. On the condition that no claims have been made or are pending, the premium will be refunded in full. If you wish to cancel after the 14 day cooling off period, please contact the organisation from whom you bought your policy.
